The steps to take!

SAFE WINTER OPERATIONS

- Complete dry-runs of route
- Make notes and mark obstacles
- Schedule tree trimming prior to winter
- Ensure crew has had adequate sleep
- Wear warm, multi-layered clothing
- Obey traffic laws
- Have a good attitude
